



PETROPERÚ ANNOUCES NEW ATTACKS AGAINST THE NORTH PERUVIAN OIL PIPELINE

Lima, Peru, January 19, 2023 – Petróleos del Perú S.A. "Petroperú" or "the Company" (OTC:PETRPE) announced today that, in one hand, on the morning of January 14, 2023, a group of protesters approached the valve at 371 Km of the section II of the North Peruvian Oil Pipeline (ONP), near the Nieva bridge, in the province of Condorcanqui, Amazonas region, with the intention of manipulated it.

Likewise, another group of protesters attacked the ONP infrastructure at 440 Km, Inayo town, Imaza district, Bagua province and they set fire to the surrounding areas.

On the other hand, a new attack against the ONP has been reported on January 16, 2023, when a group of protesters set fire to the ONP in the area close to 389 Km of Section II, near the native community El Paraíso, in the district of Chiriaco, province of Bagua, Amazonas region, as you could review in the next link:

For this reason, Petroperú denounced this serious acts that endangers the lives of the nearby population and could generate a large-scale environmental catastrophe. That's why, it requested the authorities to take the corresponding actions to protect the ONP and identify those responsible.

These new attacks on the ONP have already been communicated to the corresponding entities such as the PNP, OSINERGMIN, OEFA, MINEM, the Public Ministry, among others.

All these acts of vandalism are considered of high risk, since by affecting the integrity of the pipeline them can cause a hydrocarbon spill that -added to the fire- could generate an explosion with fatal consequences for the nearby communities and for the protesters themselves.

Petroperú has reiterated the call to stop the attacks on the infrastructure of the ONP, because it is a Critical National Asset that must be protected to guarantee a safe and sustained operation of the hydrocarbons transportation, but mostly to safeguard the people integrity and environment cares.
