

## UPDATE REGARDING PASTAZA RIVER EVENT

**Lima, Peru, October 23, 2024 – Petróleos del Peru S.A. "Petroperú" or "the Company" (OTC:PETRPE)** announces today that, in line with what the Press Release dated October 16, 2024 and in response to some organizations that make statements without contrasting with Petroperú's official versions of the work carried out by the Company in the face of environmental events beyond its control, we reiterate that the fast response actions carried out after the oil upwelling have been verified and confirmed by the Environmental Assessment and Enforcement Agency (OEFA), the Supervisory Agency for Investment in Energy and Mining (Osinergmin), and the General Directorate of Captaincies and Coast Guards (DICAPI), who have verified that the measures implemented by Petroperú were effective for the immediate control of the incident.

Regarding the cleanup work in the affected areas, Petroperú continues to carry out the cleanup work in the areas affected by the upwelling of hydrocarbons at Kms 11 and 12 of the North Branch of the Norperuano Oil Pipeline, in the area of the Pastaza River, Andoas district, Datem del Marañón province, Loreto region.

These tasks are carried out with the support of local labor, after the agreements reached through permanent dialogue with authorities and community leaders of Andoas. It is estimated to culminate with the cleanup by the end of October. At the same time, Petroperú has requested the Regional Health Management of Loreto and the National Rural Sanitation Program to carry out the analysis of the quality of water for human consumption and the monitoring of water treatment plants, in strict compliance with current regulations.

Likewise, Petroperú has acquired food and water packages for the attention of the population and has coordinated with the Regional Government of Loreto and the National Institute of Civil Defense (INDECI) for the transport of food from Iquitos to Andoas, which will be distributed by local authorities.

Following the above, the Company has requested the aforementioned organizations to make the corresponding corrections in order to guarantee the objectivity and credibility of the information for the benefit of its readers and it has reiterated its total willingness to answer the queries through its official channels.
