

PETROPERÚ REPORTS INCIDENT AT INACTIVE WELL IN BLOCK VI AND IMMEDIATE REMEDIATION ACTIONS

Lima, Peru, July 09, 2025 – Petróleos del Peru S.A. "Petroperú" or "the Company" (OTC:PETRPE) announced today that upon the immediate detection of production fluids (water, crude oil, and sludge) in the area surrounding Well 383 – Lobitos (inactive), located in Block VI in the Lobitos District, Province of Talara, the Company promptly activated the contingency plan established in its emergency response protocols.

Regrettably, initial access by our specialized response teams was delayed due to resistance from local residents, which hindered timely attention to the incident and increased the potential environmental risk.

The National Police of Peru (PNP) has been notified and is investigating to determine the root cause of the incident. Preliminary observations indicate evidence of unauthorized manipulation of the well valve and a breach of the perimeter fence. The PNP has also been requested to maintain order and facilitate ongoing clean-up efforts.

As of today, Wednesday, July 09, the affected area has been fully cleaned and restored, following remediation efforts carried out by the company's specialized personnel in coordination with the relevant sectoral authorities.

The Company has coordinated and communicated the incident and subsequent actions with both national and regional authorities, including the Ministry of Energy and Mines, the Ministry of the Environment, the Ministry of Health, the PNP, the Regional Government of Piura, the Provincial Municipality of Talara, the Municipality of Lobitos, OEFA, OSINERGMIN, and FEMA Sullana. All parties have been granted full access for oversight and information verification purposes.

Petroperú reaffirms its unwavering commitment to environmental stewardship and to maintaining strong, transparent relationships with the communities surrounding its operations.
